Still pictures: **600 x 800 and 150 dpi**
Screen Test films: max 60 sec.; saved as **.mov**, or **.mp4**, or **.avi**

 - face or figure

- Each submission must be identified with the following information:
Teacher Name, Artist Name
Title, if available
School/Grade Level
- All work will be shown two ways
Projected as part of a continuous loop
On a touch screen where visitors can select works to view
- Works will remain on display at the museum through September 8
- Images from the exhibition may be used on the museum's website
- Work must be appropriate for public display. The museum reserves the right to make final exhibition content decisions.
